Haunted Pumpkin Patch 2022 & IVRPD 50th Anniversary FAQs

What is the Haunted Pumpkin Patch and IVRPD 50th Anniversary Event?

It is a free, outdoor creative immersive Halloween experience to celebrate Isla Vista Recreation & Park District's 50th anniversary that includes 6 specific environments within Anisq'Oyo' Park as tribute to the park's founding anniversary on Halloween in 1972.

When is the event?

The event dates are Saturday October 29th through Monday October 31st, 2022, from 7pm-11pm each night in Anisq'Oyo' Park in downtown Isla Vista.

In honor of the formation of the District, IVRPD will also host a cake cutting reception on October 31st from 5:30-6:30pm at the District Office at 961 Embarcadero Del Mar that is open to the public.

What kind of activities will there be?

The event will feature a Haunted Pumpkin Patch with live-action storytelling, in addition to pumpkin adventures, film screenings, face paintings, silent disco nights, a thriller flash mob, an Altar walk, a costume contest, and Ferris Wheel with carnival games.

Who can attend the event?

The Haunted Pumpkin Patch and IVRPD 50th Anniversary Celebration is a free admission event open to all ages. All are welcome.

Where is the entrance to event?

The event has four access points: Embarcadero Del Mar x Pardall, Embarcadero Del Mar x Seville, Embarcadero del Mar x Madrid Embarcadero del Norte x Madrid.

What time does the event start?

The Haunted Pumpkin Patch is open from 7pm-11pm, with specific activities and times outlined in the flier, free pumpkin souvenirs will be offered while supplies last.

Will there be any food or water?

No, we will have water at our safety station only, we encourage patrons to enjoy the local flare of restaurants and local businesses.

What can I bring to the event?

Guests may bring lawn chairs, blankets, food, and drink. Drugs, alcohol, and weapons are expressly forbidden. Please no smoking or vaping. A posted event guidelines will also be attached to this FAQ, including the forbiddance of fake weapons as costume.

How can I access the event?
