Haunted Pumpkin Patch: An Immersive and Theatrical Experience

Event FAQ Page

What is the Haunted Pumpkin Patch?

It is a free, first-come, first-served walkthrough theatrical performance and storytelling experience hosted by IVRPD and presented by Lucidity LLC, focused on providing a safe Halloween activity in Isla Vista that people of all ages can enjoy.

When and where is the event being held?

The event dates are October 27th through October 29th, from 7pm-11pm daily at Estero Park (889 Camino Del Sur).

Who is this event intended for?

The Haunted Pumpkin patch is intended for all age groups and people of Isla Vista, including students, families, children, and elderly. Adult supervision is recommended but not required for children under the age of 10.

I noticed the Haunted Pumpkin Patch has different “environments”. What does that mean?

The Haunted Pumpkin Patch “environments” are rooms with different themes that feature audio, visual, and lighting decorations to create a unique and captivating story-telling experience for audiences. Please note that some rooms will have laser lighting effects.

What kind of themes are on display? Should I be worried about graphic nudity or violence?

The Haunted Pumpkin Patch, as a live performance, is a family-friendly storytelling experience suitable for most audiences, equivalent to a PG-13 movie. There is no explicit nudity, violence, or graphic content. Some elements of suggestive dance and body paint may apply. We have attempted to capture the spooky spirit of Halloween without the gore or terror.

Where is the entrance to the event?

The main entrance to the Pumpkin Patch is located at the western portion of Estero Park near the basketball courts and community gardens area. Guests will be guided through the Haunted Pumpkin Patch and exit the grounds by the Red Barn and St. George Youth Center.

Is there anywhere for me to park my car?

IVRPD recognizes the parking challenges in Isla Vista. Unfortunately, no parking accommodations will be available for this event. Guests are encouraged to use alternate modes of transportation to access the Pumpkin Patch, such as Santa Barbara MTD. Guests requiring ADA and other accessibility-related modifications may submit a request for accommodations by dialing (805) 968-2017 or emailing ivrpd@ivparks.org.

When should I arrive to the Pumpkin Patch?

Guests may arrive as early as 6pm on any of the three event days to secure their spot in line. Each group will receive a souvenir pumpkin while supplies last. Staff will announce last call at 10:30pm or earlier, depending on volume of crowds. The event will close at 11pm.

Am I allowed to go through as many times as I want?

Yes, guests are allowed to go through Pumpkin Patch as many times as they wish but may not receive additional souvenir pumpkins. Please note that pumpkins are limited to one per group while supplies last.

What can I bring to the Pumpkin Patch?

Cell phones and water bottles are permitted in the Pumpkin Patch. Please note that all backpacks, purses, and personal handbags will be subject to inspection. No animals allowed.

Will there be any food or water?

No food or water will be provided. Drugs and alcohol are not allowed, and please, no glass containers.

What types of security measures will be provided?

The Guardian Team, a partner of Lucidity, will be on site to provide event safety, event security, and harm reduction throughout the Pumpkin Patch event.

What types of COVID precautions are being taken?

This event will be held in compliance with all local health and safety guidelines. IVRPD is monitoring COVID-19 and will provide event updates or modifications, as needed. This event is also being conducted in accordance with all applicable Santa Barbara County festival ordinances.
